### **Chapter 1. Crop Production and Management**

• In order to provide food to our growing population, we need to adopt a certain agricultural practices.

<u>Crop</u>: When plant of the same kind are grown and cultivated at one place on a large scale, it is called a crop.

### Type of crop:

- 1. Kharif Crops 2. Rabi Crops
- 1. Kharif Crops: The crops which are shown in the rainy season (in India June to September) are called kharif crops. E.g.- paddy, maize, soya bean, groundnut, cotton etc.
- 2. Rabi Crops: The crops grown in the winter season ( October to March ) are called Rabi crops. E.g.- wheat, gram, pea, mustard and linseed.

Note- Besides these, pulses and vegetables are grown during summer (March to June) at many places. These crops are known as Zaid crops.

### **Basic practices of crop production**

Activities carried out by farmers for crop production are referred to as agricultural practices. These activities are listed below.

- 1. Preparation of soil
- 2. Sowing
- 3. Adding manure and fertilisers
- 4. Irrigation
- 5. Protecting from weeds
- 6. Harvesting
- 7. Storage
- 1. Preparation of soil
  - a. Tilling or ploughing b. Levelling
- 1. <u>Tilling or ploughing</u>: The process of loosening and turning of the soil is called tilling or ploughing.

This is done by using a plough.

2. <u>Levelling</u>: The process of breaking clumps of soil ( crumbs ) in ploughed field is called Levelling.

This is done by leveller.
