**Bridge Course:**

Like most of the world at this time, as we face the challenges of the coronavirus pandemic, schools were closed from 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2020. We began bridge course for Class I to XII from 6th April to 13th April 2020 through our school WhatsApp groups.

**Blended Learning Measures:**

- However, there were challenges to overcome. Some students without reliable internet access and technology struggled to participate in digital learning. The effectiveness of online learning varied amongst age groups, because kids got distracted easily. In order to get full benefits of online learning, concerted and continuous efforts were made by the teachers. There was integration of games that demonstrated higher engagement and increased motivation and made children truly fall in love with learning. A survey was taken by the teachers in order to know about the percentage of children attending and not attending the online classes in regular and measures were taken to assess the learning gap. Some of those measures were as follows,  
Class KG to class XII all classes are conducted online. For the benefit of the students who were not able to join, due to any reason, Videos/ PDFs were sent in the group, after the class.
- Online Tests were conducted, in the evening after the completion of chapter. Separate time slots were assigned for primary and secondary classes
- The syllabus was covered as per schedule, in a planned manner.
- Mid Term Exams were successfully conducted from 5-Oct-2020 to 22-Oct-2020. Students, who were unable to appear, were given another chance to attempt.
- 2 Unit Tests were conducted for class IX and X
- Unit Test II was conducted from 12-Dec-2020 to 24-Dec-2020.
- Unit Test II was taken Online (Google form & subjective) for classes KG to XII (excluding XI). The students were supervised while they were attempting the Question Paper, and later they sent the Images/ PDFs of their answer sheets. These Sheets were compiled by the teachers and checked on the system/ mobile.

**Goals Set**

- All the members of the staff worked with extreme dedication, our motive is to give maximum benefit to our girls with the support of their parents.
- Children unable to take the benefit of normal online classes were provided videos for offline viewing.
- Apart from normal class, extra efforts were done for such students, we provided them videos of the lessons, we integrated Art in teaching to make it fun and understand better.
- To complete the syllabus as scheduled.
- Keep record of students absent from class, while class teachers contacted them via telephone call, time to time.
- Collect application from the parents facing financial crisis. These students were re- linked to the group.
- Students participated in Co-Curricular Activities as well. Competitive Activities were given in the groups, as scheduled. Online Certificates were also awarded to the top 3 students of each class.
- Using online class to inculcate Moral values and empathy in students, while they were at home. Made them aware about the various situations of concern due to Pandemic, and how to cope.

## Success Online

- All teachers are tech-savvy and shared their best learning's with other teachers.
- Teachers have successfully attended CBSE seminars, to update themselves, in different topics of current events/ subjects of concern.
- Students had shown their interest while attempting the Exams, and we were able to conduct exams successfully, despite numerous challenges.
- Homework assignments were also conducted online.
- Subject related Activities conducted and record maintained. At least 1 project completed in every class related to each subject.
- Practicals / Projects from 9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> were also conducted online.

## Roster for teachers to complete their work from school premises

All teachers were working from home since April, for all the school related activities.

Time-Table was provided to all to conduct classes since April.

Class Co-ordinators were allotted specific duties to co-ordinate all the sections of that class and the teachers teaching those classes.

Principal and HODs conducted online meetings and coordinated with the subject teachers for smooth progress of the subjects in all classes. Lesson plans were prepared under their guidance.

Examination Department is headed by Examination I/c. All the Question Papers were sent to the department. Soft copies of all answer sheets are maintained, and Marks Entry Completed time to time.

The Mid-Term Exams were planned to be conducted from school. But after 1 week, due to the spread of Corona and lockdown, they had to conduct the exams from home, in the same manner as they started in school.

From **18<sup>th</sup> of January 2021**, students of classes 9,10 11 &12 were coming to school to attend classes. From 8<sup>th</sup> Feb students of classes 6to 8 started coming.

Only 50% of the students were allowed to come on a day. Some Parents were still not willing to send their children to school so they also joined online.

Teachers were generating online classes along with offline classes from school.

Since 21<sup>st</sup> January we are calling entire staff to school. So, all online classes were generated from school.

PTM was conducted on 25<sup>th</sup> Feb. for Pre- Board I of class X. Since they appeared for the written exam for the first time from the school, so all their scopes of improvement were explained.

After the result of the Pre-board the not so good performers were listed and their parents were convinced to send their ward to school, in the month of April regularly.

## Challenges Faced and overcome

- Teachers working with mobile phones only
- Network issue with Teachers/ Students
- Teachers who were technical challenged in beginning
- Sibling having class at the same time
- Conducting exam

## Faculty Development Activities

All teachers have attended a 3 Days Faculty Development program, which was conducted by St. Vincent Pallotti, College of Engg. & Technology, Nagpur, Maharashtra.

Topic – “Online Teaching-Learning Process using ICT Tools for Education” .

Duration – 3rd to 5<sup>th</sup> July, 2020

This training program was the need of the hour and proved to be beneficial for all teachers.

Several CBSE/ DIKSHA Webinars, related to various topics, were registered with and attended by all teachers. (Minimum 5 webinars were made compulsory).

## Department Meetings

Monthly online meetings were conducted with the teachers.

Department Record was prepared every month and the attendance record, Video of lesson record, test record, lesson plans, syllabus completion details were maintained.

**Subject enrichment activities** aimed at the understanding and skill development of children. Those activities permitted students to apply knowledge to the next level. It sustained the enthusiasm of students to put their best foot forward.

Student's portfolio included notebook and self-assessment which were effectively evaluated. Since peer assessment was impossible through online platform, self-assessment provided opportunity to children to evaluate their own task.

All these assessments focused on how well students had learnt the skills from the learning targets through online class.

## . Remedial Measures:

After finding the average percentage of children lagging behind, remedial measures were taken by our school as follows,

- As many parents were working and only one android phone is at home, flexibility was given in the submission of assignments and exam timings.
- School has understood the situation of the parents(financial crisis) and it had never denied any hindrance in education even when the child had not paid the pending fee of last year.
- Taking into consideration the financial difficulties of parents school Management did not force any parent to buy mobile phone/Lap top/computer for online class
- The teachers were given technical training for the assessment of students learning.

### Digital Library: • My Book My Friend Campaign-reg 23-04-2020

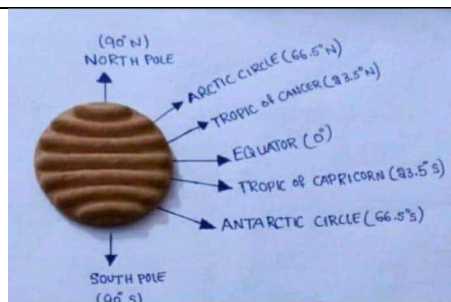

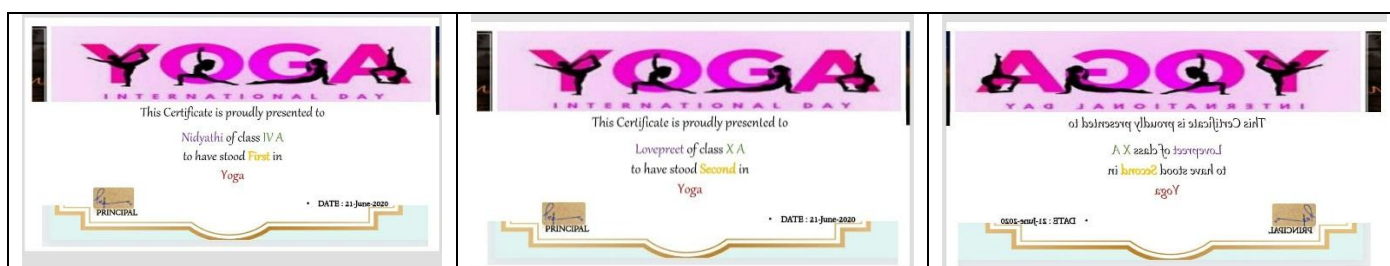

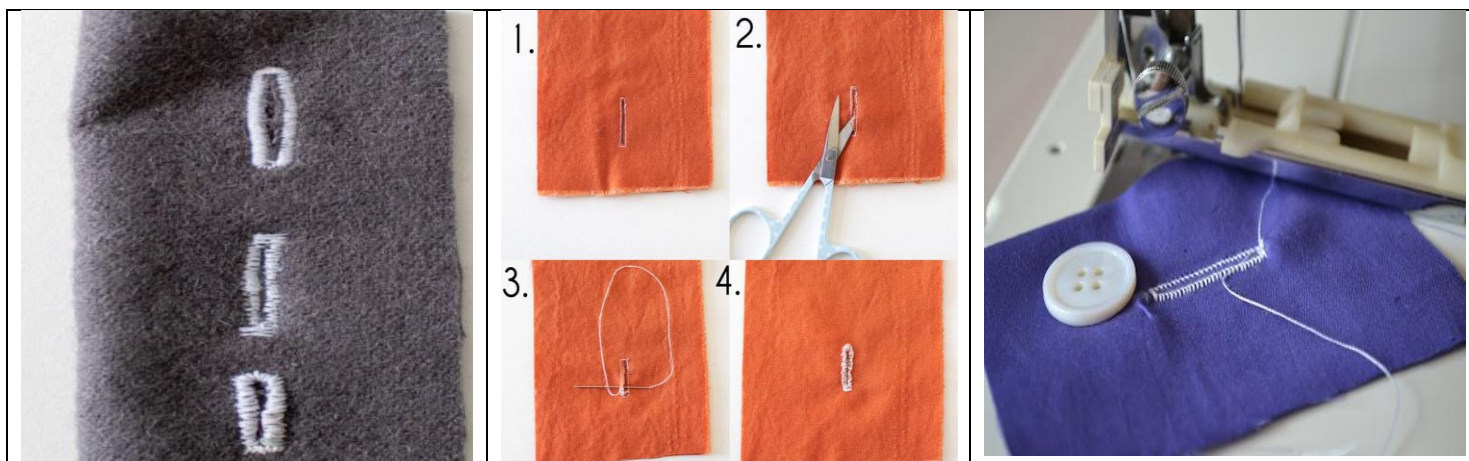
