GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Send confirmation of your team's participation by mail at infovidhyasagarschool@gmail.com
- 2. Team incharges will stay with their respective teams all the times.
- 3. Host school will provide lodging and boarding. The charges are **Rs 350/-** per for Food + **100/-** for Loading/Boarding head per day as per CBSE instructions.
- 4. Payment for food will be on full day basis and no payment in partial will be received/ refunded (as per CBSE)
- 5. All teams managers and participants must report at the registration counter and collect the Food Coupons and Room Numbers immediately on arrival.
- 6. Parents of the participants will not be allowed to stay with the wards in the school premises.
- 7. Refundable security of **Rs. 3000/-** will be taken as caution money in advance for any type of breakage or loss to the school property. The mangers/coaches of the teams all fully responsible for any damage to the school property.
- 8. Team Manager will deposit a '**No due slips'** before departure.
- 9. Players must bring with them the valid ID card for the current year signed by the Principal.
- 10. Copy of online proforma duly attested by Principal.
- 11. The team photo with school Principal along the copy of online entry proforma countersigned by Principal.
- 12. No team shall be accompanied by more than two officials.
- 13. The officials accompanying the team shall have a valid identity card issued by the school and duly signed by the Principal.
- 14. It is compulsory for all participant schools to attend the inaugural ceremony in complete school uniform/ school tracksuit. All teams **MUST** bring their school flags with them.

- 15. All the students will report in prescribed School Uniform only.
- 16. Date, Time and Mode of arrivals should be intimated well in advance so that arrangement can be made accordingly.
- All outstation teams to report at Vidhya Sagar School campus on
 05 Dec 2022 by 10 am
- 18. In case of girls' participants, one of the accompanying officials must be a female.
- 19. No extra person shall be permitted to stay inside the school premises and on the play field along with the teams.
- 20. It is mandatory for all the teams to take food from the school mess.
- 21. 'Pick & Drop' facility will be provided to outstation teams from railway station and bus stand, Jaipur.
- 22. The decision taken by jury will be final and binding for all teams and managers. Protest of any nature along with Rs. 1000/- (non-refundable)should reach the Technical Committee in writing within one hour of the declaration of the result.
- 23. Participants are requested not to bring valuable items such as jewellery, mobile, camera, iPod and other electronic gadgets, etc.
- 24. Consumption of liquor, drugs, tobacco in any form is strictly prohibited during the conduct of tournament and stay in the school. Any violation of rule would lead to disqualification.

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS

- 1. Every affiliated school is entitled to enter its team in the CBSE West Zone Taekwondo Competitions 2020-23
- 2. No school will be permitted to participate unless they fill the online discipline-wise Entry Performa and by-hand Entry Performa would not be accepted.
- 3. No team will be permitted to participate unless accompanied by a teacher/coach at the venue.
- 4. All the outstation teams will be lodged in the school premises. Team in need of stay facility must inform on or before **30 Nov 2022.**
- 5. Each participant/school must remit **Rs.450.00 per head per day** against lodging and boarding. Money will be collected/deposited against boarding and lodging on full day basis and no part payment will be collected or deposited and the participating schools will not insist for refund of part payment.
- 6. Dining in the mess arranged by the host school is mandatory for the teams that opt to stay in the school provided accommodation. Please note that once your school offers its consent to take meal in our school it cannot be altered later on to avoid any embarrassment and wastage on the host school.
- 7. It is not obligatory on the part of Organizing School to provide food & transport facility to school/teams making their own stay arrangements. Also, it is the responsibility of the school/teams staying outside, to collect information in regard to matches/fixtures/program etc.
- 8. Every participant team shall carry with them the required documents as mentioned under title "Eligibility".
- 9. Every team will carry their school flag, for the purpose of March past and to be used during the various ceremonies. Participation in March past is compulsory, failing which their right to participate can be forfeited.
- 10. Any non-designated person accompanying the team will not be entertained for any matter at the venue and will not be permitted to stay in the premises.

ACCREDITED REPRESENTATIVES (TEACHER/COACH/MANAGER)

- 11. All the teams shall be accompanied by a Teacher/Coach/Manager designated by the participating school Principal.
- 12. No team will be permitted to participate without accompanying official.
- 13. No team shall be accompanied by more than two officials.

- 14. No team shall be accompanied by any parent. However if a parent is accompanying the team, such information may be provided by the school on the school letterhead.
- 15. The officials accompanying the team shall have a valid Identity Card issued by their school Principal. No extra person shall be permitted to stay inside the school premises and on the play field along with the teams.

ENTRIES

16. Soon after filling-in the entry proforma, schools shall make travel bookings and send the information to the Organizing school for making the necessary arrangements.

17. Whatsoever the reason may be, on the spot entry and late entry will not be entertained.

WITHDRAWING SCHOOL

- 18. If a school, after filling-in its entry, wishes to withdraw from the championship, it shall give a written request of its intention to do so to the Principal **Vidhya Sagar Sr. Sec. School Jaipur.**
- 19. School withdrawing without informing/requesting the Organizing school, will be penalized with a penalty or Rs.1000/-.

DISQUALIFICATIONS

A player/team may be disqualified/scratched for the following reasons.

- 1. If the ineligibility of any member of the team is detected.
- 2. Inclusion of non bonafide student in the team.
- 3. Misbehavior on ground by athlete or accompanying official.
- 4. Use of abusive language by players or accompanying official.
- 5. Misbehavior with Officials/Opponents by players or accompanying official.
- 6. Indiscipline at the place of stay by players or accompanying official.
- 7. Damaging the school property.
- 8. Indiscipline during the Opening and Closing ceremonies by the players or accompanying official.
- 9. Non participation in March Past.

IMPORTANT

It would be mandatory:-

(i) To provide the documents for verification in original if asked for.

(ii) To supply the team photo with school Principal along with the entry Performa, countersigned by the concerned Principal.

(iii) For student/player studying in class IX and above, to provide CBSE registration number.

Eligibility/Entry Performa

CBSE RULES : TAEKWONDO (Girls" & Boys)

- 1. The competition will be held as per the Rules & Regulations of the Taekwondo Federation of India unless modified in these rules.
- 2. The competition will be held at Zone and National level.
- 3. At Zone level, one player from each school can participate in each weight category, separately in Girls" & Boys" group.
- 4. From each Zone, in each weight category, separately in Girls" & Boys" group, only first position winning player shall qualify to participate in the Nationals.
- 5. Schools organizing the championship must arrange and provide the Chest guard & Head gear to the participants.
- 6. Participants must wear own WTF approved Groin guard; Forearm guard & Shin guard.
- 7. The competition shall be conducted in the following age & weight categories:-

- 8. No player shall be below 10 years so as to participate in the championship.
- 9. The participants are advised to register themselves with the TFI and obtain the ID Card after paying the registration charges and filling the prescribed form available at the TFI web site www.tfiindia.com Once registered, they can participate in all the TFI organized championships.
- 10. The player shall be allowed to participate only in their respective weight category and no jumping in the weight category shall be permitted (actual body weight).
- 11. Weigh-in shall be conducted one day prior to the day of competition.
- 12. There shall be at least four competitors in a particular weight category so as to conduct the competition.
- 13. The time duration for competition shall be as per the WTF rule.
- 14. Each competition arena should have four corner judges, one center referee, one recorder & one time keeper.
- 15. The competition shall be conducted on Single Elimination Tournament System.
- 16. Team winners will be decided by the following pattern:
 - i. Each eligible contestant will score 01 point.
 - ii. Contestant will get 01 point for every winning match (Including a bye)
 - iii. Gold Medal will be awarded 07 points.
 - iv. Silver Medal will be awarded 03 points.
 - v. Bronze Medal will be awarded 01 point
- 17. Merit Certificate will be provided to first, second & third positions winners. (Both the semifinalist will be provided the certificate of Merit and Bronze Medal for the third place).
- 18. All other participant's will be provided with the participation certificates.
- 19. All other participant's will be provided with the participation certificates.
- 20. The Arbitration Board Members/Protest Committee shall include: Principal Organizing School; Organizing Secretary; CBSE Observer & In-charge Technical Officials/Chief Referee.
