

Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation

Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) is a system of school based evaluation of student's that covers all aspects of student development.

It means regularity of assessment, frequency of unit testing, diagnosis of learning gaps, use of corrective measure, retesting and feedback of evidence to teachers and students for their self evaluation.

Scholastic and Co-Scholastics Assessment

In order to implement continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation, both scholastics and Co-Scholastics aspects are given due recognition.

Evaluation of Scholastic aspect

Scholastic Areas

Evaluation of Academic Subjects in Classes IX and X.

Six Assessment are proposed :

Type of assessment	Percentage of Weighting in academic session	Month	Termwise Weighting
Formative Assessment-1	10%	April-May	FA 1 + FA 2 = 20%
Formative Assessment-2	10%	July-August	---
Formative Assessment-1	30%	September	SA 1 = 30%

Second Term

Formative Assessment-3	10%	Oct-Nov	FA 3 + FA 4 = 20%
Formative Assessment-4	10%	Jan-Feb	---
Formative Assessment-2	30%	March	SA 2 = 30%

First Term : FA 1 (10%) + FA 2 (10%) + SA 1 (30%) = 50%

Second Term : FA 3 (10%) + FA 4 (10%) + SA 2 (30%) = 50%

Formative Assessment : FA 1 (10%) + FA 2 (10%) + FA 3 (10%) + FA 4 (10%) = 40%

Formative Assessment : SA 1 (30%) + SA 2 (30%) = 50%

Grading Scale

Assessment of Scholastic attainments Part 1 will be reported twice in a year.

The nine point grading scale for measuring scholastic achievement given below :

Minimum qualifying grade in all the subjects under Scholastic Domain is D.

All assessment with regard to the academic status of the students shall be done in marks and the assessment will be given in grades.

Assessment of Co-Scholastic Areas 2 (A, B, C & D) and 3 (A, B) will be done on 5 point scale (shown in the table below) : reported once in class IX and once in class X.

Grade	Grade Point
A	4.1 - 5.0
B	3.1 - 4.0
C	2.1 - 3.0
D	1.1 - 2.0
E	0 - 1.0

Minimum qualifying grade in Co-Scholastic Domain is D.
